Subject: Kingdom of Bahrain Flag and BMF Logo

This amendment is issued under the provisions of Article 4 of the BMF National Sporting Code.

In line with the Bahrain Motor Federation's (BMF) commitment to fostering national pride and elevating the Kingdom of Bahrain's global presence in motorsport, all competitors are required to adhere to specific identification standards. These standards enhance the visibility of both the Kingdom and the Federation while unifying competitors under a shared symbol of excellence and national representation.

Accordingly, the following addition to "**BMF National Sporting Code - Appendix One – Schedule L**" outlines the mandatory use of race overall patches displaying the Kingdom of Bahrain flag or insignia alongside the official BMF logo:

12. Requirement for Display of Bahrain Motor Federation Identification:

12.1. Display Requirements: All competitors holding a valid Bahrain Motor Federation (BMF) license are required to prominently display:

- (a) The Kingdom of Bahrain flag or insignia, and
(b) The official BMF logo,

on their racing overalls, in accordance with the specifications and guidelines provided by the BMF.

12.2. Distribution and Placement Guidelines: The required patches will be distributed to all BMF license holders. Detailed instructions regarding the approved placement and method of affixation will accompany the patches.

12.3. Mandatory Compliance: Wearing the patches is mandatory for participation in all BMF-sanctioned national events. This requirement also applies to competitors representing Bahrain or participating under a BMF license in regional and international competitions. Competitors or drivers who are unable to fulfill this requirement in international competitions due to restrictions from specific branding guidelines must notify and clarify their status with the BMF.

12.4. Non-Compliance: Non-compliance with this requirement will result in penalties or sanctions by the BMF as outlined in the BMF National Sporting Code and its Appendices.
