Subject: Breach of BMF Code

This amendment is issued under the provisions of the BMF National Sporting Code Article 17(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorized to the text of the Supplementary Regulation of the above named event. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

The BMF has learned that a Competitive Event took place at BIKC on 1st Feb and 5th Feb 2019. This event was promoted by a foreign unlicensed entity (Arabian knights mini GP) and took place at the BIKC with the knowledge of the staff.

The event was run in violation of the National Sporting Code and communication that was relayed to BIKC by BMF for the Xstream events that took place in 2018.

The BMF mandates that BIKC:

1. This is a repeat offense and the BIKC should be more careful with the events that are taking place



2. Cease to allow such events to take place - specifically those that award points and are based on unsanctioned rules and regulations. All points from these 2 events and previous rounds MUST be removed from the SWS Website.
3. Prepare a public statement of apology for its actions of "conducting and running unsanctioned competitive events without adhering to the National Sporting Code"
4. Further to the above, the BMF issues a fine of BD 1200/- to be paid by BIKC within 2 weeks from the date of this decision
5. In future if this is repeated a more severe penalty will be taken against BIKC
