In line with directives received by the Government of Bahrain's Executive Committee and the Bahrain Olympic Committee, the Bahrain Motor Federation (BMF) has received clearance to resume sporting activities in mid July 2020; these activities were previously postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

However, after evaluating weather conditions and due to the outdoor nature of our sport, the BMF deems that running these outdoor events as challenging during the extreme summer conditions and would be severe and unsafe for both competitors and officials.

Therefore, and in accordance with Articles 13 & 14 of the BMF National Sporting Code, the BMF officially deems the Motorsport Championship Season 2019/2020 as concluded and officially cancels (without substitution) the following events from the Season's Calendar:

- 1) BIC 2000cc Challenge Round 7
- 2) BMR 600 Round 7
- 3) BKSC Round 6 and 7
- 4) Auto cross Round 4

**The current championship standings for the incomplete BMF Championships will thus be considered as the Final Championship Classification.**

**This decision is not susceptible to Appeals.**

**Reason for change:**

- 1. Due to high temperature; this will have a direct effect on officials, drivers, cars, bikes and karts**
- 2. Due to closed borders; GCC drivers won't be able to attend our championship which will affect their results**
